

Ian Moore bags a new PB!

After a lengthy work and sport enforced lay-off from overnights, CCM Director Ian Moore returned to catching with a bang whilst fishing a recent 36 hour session at his chosen big carp and coarse fish venue.

Arriving at Wayne Little's Milton Abbas Lake early on Sunday morning Ian set up his 'plot' in a likely looking area where fish had been visiting on a regular basis during the previous week. Knowing of the consistent successes achieved by Martin Brent and other anglers using the superb Odyssey XXX bait, Ian trickled the high GLM freezer bait onto his chosen spots throughout the duration of his first overnight session in 15 months.

This little and often feeding tactic soon brought Ian success in the shape of 18lb and 17lb 4oz mirrors, and this cracking 24lb linear before lunchtime on the first day of the session.



After introducing a couple of kilos of Odyssey XXX onto another spot in a neighbouring area Ian's hookbait was soon picked up again, this time at around 60-70 yards range. After a spirited fight which took the fish into one of the diminishing weed beds in the central areas of the 8-acre venue, Ian finally netted what he saw to be the prize 'Baby Common' at a new personal best and venue record of 45lb 8oz.



It's nice to see he can still catch them even if he doesn't get much practice these days. We think the bait may have helped a bit too!!

Ian finished his memorable session with a 23lb+ fish and has now vowed to get out more often.....we'll wait and see!
