

Tips for the Summer Attractor Pack by Rich Seeds



- Brilliant for mesh PVA bags, you can add oil to the pellets before putting them in pva bags or dip the whole bag into the oil just before casting out.



- I like to have a spare bucket or bag so I can keep some of the pellets dry and then soak some in the oil. The dry pellets I would use to feed spots; these are ideal for use in the margins. I then use pellets glugged in a small mesh bag to add attraction to the hook bait area and draw the fish to your bait.

- The oil can also be poured into solid bags to help boost them.
- The oil is great for adding to groundbait as it really keeps the attraction in the area for a long time as the oils soaks into and onto the small particles. As the ground bait balls break down it will continue to leak into the water.
- The hookbaits are brilliant for fishing over particles and my favourite; pva bags.
- The pellets can also be used in groundbaits and spod mixes
- You can use the oily bait as an indication to the presence fish in your swim as when they feed on or disturb the bait containing oils you can often get 'slicks' of oil appear on the surface.
