

'Farriers' treble for Dan

We would like to congratulate young Dan Davies who has recently reported a great result from Farriers Lake in the Cotswolds.

Dan set up for a 48 hour session in a bay which was being battered by strong south westerly winds and driving rain, confident in the knowledge that his rods were baited with two boilies which the Farriers fish has shown to have a real taste for during randomly fished sessions by several anglers over the past few years. Even though there have rarely been anglers using Odyssey XXX and Live System on the Gloucestershire venue, whenever they have been used the success they have often achieved really has been noticeable.

When you've got four great boilies to choose from, why only use one?

Dan figured that the increasingly popular 'dual-bait' approach that is used by some of the top CC Moore anglers may well be the tactic to use on Farriers so baited different rigs with Odyssey XXX and Live System boilies in an attempt to trick the fish. On the first night of the session his tactics certainly paid off as he banked three of the weedy venue's fish, weighing in at a mightily impressive 38lb 13oz, 36lb 14oz and 23lb 5oz.



Here is the cracking 38lb 13oz common caught by Dan Davies during his first night at Farriers Lake using Odyssey XXX boilies.

The 23lb 5oz fish was the only mirror caught by Dan and was in fact the only fish he caught on the Live System. Both of the 30lb+ commons fell to his rig baited with Odyssey XXX boilies

For all of the three fish, Dan baited with around 150 baits per rod and cast onto spots in clearings in the weed.

Well done on a great result Dan!
