

## Liquid Bloodworm Extract & Frozen Bloodworm Review – by Ollie Pearce

When bites are hard to come by in the warmer months and the fish become difficult to tempt on man-made baits due to a plentiful supply of natural food, incorporating a few natural food items within your baited traps can only be an advantage.

Bloodworm is without a doubt one of the most talked-about and legendary carp attractors. CCM Liquid Bloodworm Extract and Frozen Bloodworm blocks combine brilliantly together and help to stack the odds in favour of the angler using them.



Both of these products have a multitude of uses. Liquid Bloodworm Extract can be used to dampen stick mixes, added to spod mixes and also poured into solid PVA bags which results in a cloud of natural feeding triggers surrounding your hookbait. It is also a great product for rehydrating boilies that have been air dried for a

prolonged period of time. Frozen Bloodworm makes a brilliant addition to any spod mix and can be used in conjunction with Frozen Water Snails, Chopped Tigers (use sparingly) and Hemp/Buck Wheat to create a naturally crunchy and irresistible mix that isn't overpowering or loaded with synthetic flavours.



Due to the small nature of all of the above particles, it is best to keep hookbaits fairly small so that they are less obtrusive and match the free offerings as closely as possible. Bloodworm barrels are an obvious choice, although small tiger nuts are well worth a go too!
