

# Hellraisers

I first started using Hellraisers at Horseshoe Lake to help me overcome the weed. I have found when used on a snowman rig with a 14mm CC Moore bottom bait it balances perfectly and will sink very slowly through the water, meaning it will land gently on top of the weed.



In the past I have used numerous other companies' bottom baits and 10mm pop-ups and have found when fished together they still pop right up off the lead, not giving the slow sinking effect. This means you have to trim down the pop-up, but with CC Moore 14mm bottom baits and 10mm Hellraisers you don't have to do this.

I have had great success on both Sweet Cream and Strawberry Ice Cream Hellraisers, especially when runs have been hard to come by. I put this partly down to the colours of the baits, as pink and white can be seen in even the murkiest of waters and as tested are still visual at 9-10 foot depths in quite coloured water.

I favour either pink or white combined with Odyssey XXX as my bottom bait, and keep them glugged in Feedstim XP; then I have a very visual and balanced bait along with a very high attract bottom bait which will continue to work for several hours, giving off a strong scent that really stimulates fish to feed.



This can be a deadly method on high pressured day ticket waters and when fishing for one bite at a time with a small stick or bag.

My bag consists of one crushed Odyssey XXX boilie (from the ones I have glugged in Feedstim XP), some Mini Ultramix Pellets and a small amount of rock salt.



The fished bag is around the size of a 50p, just a mouthful - and enough to get me a quick bite. Hopefully you should find this as effective as I have on pressured lakes and day ticket waters.
