

LIQUID SUPER SLOP - Tim Richardson



The first time I used Liquid Super Slop was in winter ground baits and homemade winter boilies. I tested it locally on roach when fishing with sweetcorn, and found that when the corn was dipped into this totally natural trigger-based additive bites became instantaneous; so I knew this was something very special indeed!

You might think – so what, you caught a whole shoal of big roach but who wants that I'm a carp, barbel, chub or catfish angler! Well I always try to exploit smaller fish activity on baits to draw bigger fish because this competition really does encourage more competitive feeding and confusion in the swim - and very frequently gets the more wary big fish hooked for sure! The first ground bait I put out for carp back in February 2009 with very high levels of Liquid Super Slop produced a jacuzzi of carp bubbles on the surface plus the only take on Elphicks North Lake that night...

One of the great things you will notice about it is how it releases particles off baits that spread out and disperse through the water at different rates and in different particle sizes. I tried to use a syringe to inject into some of my special homemade baits and PVA bags too, but naturally the suspended bits in the Liquid Super Slop blocked the needle, (saying that I changed the needle diameter and carried on!) But as carp primarily filter feed on baits before actually sampling them this stuff is unsurprisingly incredibly effective!

In summer you might team it up with Liquid Salmon and Krill Extract (one of my real favourites), or with Tiger Nut Extract and oil, or Super Cherry Amino, Liquid Bloodworm Extract and Trout and Salmon Pellet Oil etc. Or in winter why not team up Liquid Super Slop with Liquid Betaine, Liquid Chilli Extract and Liquid Belachan Extract or Red Venom Liquid Food etc (so many awesome choices!)

I tried testing a highly soluble homemade winter hook bait packed with Liquid Super Slop and watched as all the various liquids and particles oozed away from the bait – magic stuff. It is now an additive I wouldn't make a bait without, and it can fortunately be used on

pellets and particles, ground baits, stick, method, slop and method mixes and pastes etc with equal success!

Try adding CC Moore Liquid Super Slop with Feedstim XP, Liquid Liver, Liquid Belachan Extract, Liquid Mussel Extract or Liquid Chilli Extract when freezing baits to really boost them! Liquid Super Slop is potentially, to my mind, a classic complex nutritionally-stimulating cornerstone of a great bait. On its own or teamed with other CC Moore liquid foods it is simply super-powerful and can provide pure confidence straight from the bottle!
